Maddy's family need our support
not our judgment, appeals MP



ULSTER was urged last night to continue praying for the safe return of Madeleine McCann, who was abducted in Portugal a fortnight ago.

DUP MP Iris Robinson, left, made the call after meeting the four-year-old's aunt and uncle Philomena and John McCann at Westminster yesterday.

Mrs Robinson, a mother and a grandmother herself, described the abduction from the McCann family's holiday apartment in Praia da Luz on May 3 as "every

And she appealed to the public not to judge the toddler's parents for leaving their children without a babysitter on the night of Madeleine's disappearance.
